

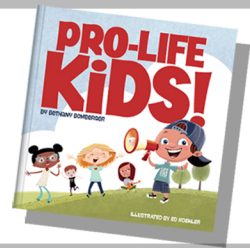

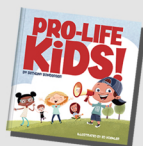
READ

- 2 Please answer at least four of the questions below. To help formulate your answers, you can watch the **videos** on these topics linked here. There are no parameters on how many (or how few) words or paragraphs you need to answer. Just write enough to show you have a clear and reasoned understanding.
 - What is abortion?
 - What was Roe v. Wade?
 - What about human value?
 - What support exists for single moms?
 - What is a pregnancy center?
 - What about a difficult diagnosis for the baby?
 - What about adoption?
 - What help exists for the uninsured?
- 3 Since Roe v Wade was overturned, laws about abortion have returned to the states. What are the abortion laws in your state? (Click **here** to find out.) Briefly outline what they are.
